

Community Health Worker (CHW) students may or may not have the opportunity to witness or gain hands on experience with all listed objectives. If the student is not exposed to a listed objective the supervisor should discuss these objectives with the student, allowing the student to ask questions. Any questions or concerns regarding meeting objectives should be directed to the course instructor.

Agency policies	The student is introduced to the agencies policies and procedures.		
Personal boundaries	The student understands their scope of practice as a CHW and the appropriate level of personal involvement with clients.		
Personal safety	The student understands the necessary measures to ensure their personal safety.		
Documentation	The student is introduced to the agencies documentation procedures and follows all confidentiality laws.		
Data collection	The Student will observe and participate in patient intake and data collection as it pertains to the client's health or health determinates.		
Liaison/Referral/Advocacy	The student will observe and/or participate in events that related to: Serving as a liaison between clients and or a health care provider or social service, providing the client referral to appropriate services, and advocating for the client when necessary as well as teaching self-advocacy skills.		
Networking	The student will be introduced to resources and other professionals in the field.		

Behavior change	The student will observe/participate in discussing behavior change as well as teaching appropriate behavior change skills.		
Community outreach	The student will have the opportunity to participate in community outreach events.		
Critical thinking	The student will be encouraged to develop and employ critical thinking skills.		
Problem solving	The student will be encouraged to develop and employ problem solving skills.		
Team work	The student will have the opportunity to work together with others on projects or tasks.		
Resiliency training	The student will demonstrate personal resiliency skills. The student may observe/teach resiliency skills to clients as appropriate.		
Motivational Interviewing	The student will observe/participate in motivational interviewing techniques with clients.		
Patient Education	The student will have the opportunity to research, develop and employ patient education information.
