

WHO ARE THEY FOR?

Child and Teen Checkups are a benefit for children and teens under age 21 who are enrolled in any Medical Assistance plan

WHAT DOES IT INCLUDE?

- Head-to-toe physical exam
- Measurements on growth and development
- Health history
- Hearing and vision screening
- Immunizations

- Lab tests as needed
- Oral health screening
- Social-emotional health
- Mental health screening
- Age-related screenings
- Education on healthy living

WHEN SHOULD MY CHILD HAVE A CHECKUP?

- Between birth and 1 month
- 2, 4, 6, 9, 12, 15, 18, 24, and 30 months
- Every year starting at age 3 20 years

WHERE CAN MY CHILD HAVE A VISIT?

Children or teens enrolled in a health plan must receive their checkups from providers in their network. Medical Assistance pays for Child and Teen Checkups.

WHY ARE VISITS IMPORTANT?

- Regular checkups help keep children and teens healthy!
- It's a great time to talk to your provider about healthy choices or any developmental concerns.
- Teens and young adults can learn to take charge of their own health.
- C&TC visits can be used for Head Start, WIC, school, childcare and camp!
